Summer activity around the feeding station is like watching an animated movie. Adults fly down with their young for lessons in getting food and water, flitting from one antic juvenile to the next in a rapid-fire exhibition of maneuvers. Now you can experience the frenzy with your own bird. Using the diagrams and instructions below, turn a simple piece of paper into a complex pattern of folds for flapping.

Origami Flapping Bird

This preliminary fold (1-4) is used to begin many origami figures, including the Bird Base.

Start by folding a square piece of paper in half diagonally to form a triangle. Fold the triangle in half to form a second triangle, then follow the drawings at right (1-4) and below (5-9).



Lift top triangle until it is perpendicular to the bottom one




Push down upper tip, squishing it to form model shown in 3.




Turn model over and repeat 1 and 2.



The result is the Bird Base.



- 70 Pull up left bottom flap of the Bird Base in a reverse fold. Make reverse fold on right a bit lower.
- 8 Make head with reverse fold and gently roll down wings.
- 9 Hold bird under front of wings; push and pull tail to make wings flap.
